On April 21, 2015 the AAR conducted an S-2034 inspection of Curry Rail Services facility located in Hollidaysburg, PA. Based on review of the inspection results by the AAR's Equipment Engineering Committee, I am pleased to advise that this facility meets the requirements of Standard S-2034 and Curry Rail Services is hereby Conditionally Approved as a builder of new freight cars. As part of this Conditional Approval, an addition inspection will be required once Curry begins manufacturing cars.

Listing as Conditionally Approved is a requirement of S-2034. Newly approved facilities remain classified as Conditionally Approved until they have produced 500 freight cars or reached five years of production. You may request a change in this listing once production reaches this level or five years has passed.
